Supply List

Tubes of the following acrylic paints:

Cadmium Red, Cadmium Yellow (light), Cobalt Blue, Sap Green, Dioxazine Purple, and a large tube of Titanium White .

Preferred brands are Grumbacher, Master's Touch, and Basics (Liquitex).

Brushes:

A large 2 inch brush for painting backgrounds

One size 8 round bristle

One size 10 flat

Taklon fiber brushes are medium priced brushes and work well with acrylic paint.

Two size 16 x 20 stretched canvases or canvas panels

An aluminum or wood table easel: There are several easels available for participants to use in the classroom on a first come first serve basis.

Palette for mixing paints: This should be a **white** non-porous surface. You might want to purchase one with a cover to avoid spills while transporting your paints. A watercolor palette will not work with acrylics because you will need a larger space to mix the paints. An alternative would be an old white porcelain plate or **heavy duty** white paper plates.

A fine mist spray bottle for water and paper towels

A large box (or the lid) to safely transport your 16 x 20 wet painting

In addition you will need a plastic table cloth to cover the work service and an old shirt to protect your clothing.

Water containers and hair dryers will be provided to help speed up the drying process.
