

## Acrylic Painting – Flowers & Landscapes

### Supply List

Tubes of the following acrylic paints:

Cadmium Red, Cadmium Yellow (light), Cobalt Blue, Sap Green, Dioxazine Purple, and a large tube of Titanium White

Preferred brands are Grumbacher, Master's Touch, and Basics (Liquitex).

Brushes:

A large 2 inch brush for painting backgrounds

One size 8 round bristle

One size 10 flat

Taklon fiber brushes are medium priced brushes and work well with acrylic paint.

Two size 16 x 20 stretched canvases or canvas panels

An aluminum or wood table easel - There are several easels available for participants to use in the classroom on a first come first serve basis.

Palette for mixing paints: This should be a **white** non-porous surface for mixing paints. You might want to purchase one with a cover to avoid spills while transporting your paints. A watercolor palette will not work with acrylics because you will need a larger space to mix the paints. An alternative would be an old white porcelain plate or **heavy duty** white paper plates.

A fine mist spray bottle for water

Paper towels

In addition you will need a plastic table cloth to cover the work service and an old shirt to protect your clothing.

Water containers will be provided
