

Alcohol Inks

Supply List

- Alcohol inks: A package of 3 colors retails at \$10.00 per package and can be purchased at Joann Fabrics in the craft section or you can order on line @ <http://www.joann.com/tim-holtz-adirondack-alcohol-ink-3pk/prd28858.html#q=alcohol%20ink&start=1>
Suggestion: buy 2 or more packages of your favorite colors and share or trade with classmates.
- Stamp pad with one package precut felt pads (approximately \$5.00)
- Small Craft brushes (package of assorted) not fine art quality
- One small package of Q-tips
- One bottle of 91% Isopropyl alcohol: this must be 91% or the project will not work
- One package cotton balls
- One roll of paper towels
- Yupo paper (optional) this paper can be expensive: an alternative would be a tablet of shiny palette paper (any size as long as it is **non-porous**)
- Small scraps of metal/glass: such as parts of old jewelry; metal washers; glass bottles with labels removed; precut glass from an existing frame; metal frames, often found in Goodwill, Mission Mart or the Salvation Army
- White ceramic tiles: an assortment of sizes from any of the builder supply stores (Lowe's, Menards, etc.) Please do not buy an entire box of tiles. They can usually be found separately out of the boxes for approximately less than a \$1.00 each.
- **MUST HAVE:**
 - *Heavy flannel-backed tablecloth (with no holes) for covering the work surface.
 - *Old clothes, smocks, aprons, shoes (ink will not come out of stained items).
 - *One package plastic vinyl gloves (alcohol inks stain fingers)
