

## Color Harmony with Acrylics

### Supply List

- One tube of white and one tube of each of the following colors: Titanium White, Permanent Red, Cobalt Blue, Cadmium Yellow (light or deep) Acceptable brands are Grumbacher or Liquitex (Basics). Golden is the best choice, but more expensive.
- Brushes: A large 2 inch flat brush for painting backgrounds; one size 8 round bristle; a size 10 flat. Taklon fiber brushes are medium priced brushes and work well with acrylic paint.
- Two size 16 x 20 stretched canvases or canvas panels
- An aluminum or wood table easel: There are several easels available for participants to use in the classroom on a first come first serve basis.
- Palette for mixing paints: This should be a **white** non-porous surface for mixing paints. You might want to purchase one with a cover to avoid spills while transporting your paints. A watercolor palette will not work with acrylics because you will need a larger space to mix the paints. An alternative would be an old white porcelain plate or **heavy duty white** paper plates.
- A fine mist spray bottle for water
- Paper towels
- A plastic table cloth to cover the work service
- An old shirt to protect your clothing
- Water containers will be provided
